

OHS RISK ASSESSMENT

Course Objectives

The new workplace health and safety Act requires an employer to make a suitable and sufficient assessment of the risks to workers and others who may be affected by their undertakings.

The course is designed to provide guidance for the identification of hazards associated with the working environment and the principles to be applied in relation to carrying out suitable risk assessments so as to ensure staff safety and business continuity. This course will equip the participants with the basic knowledge to develop a risk assessment system that meets the WSH (Risk Management) Regulation requirements

Course Outline

- Review the key elements of qualitative and quantitative risk-analysis methods
- Review MOM guidelines on risk assessment
- Develop risk assessment procedures
- Understand how to select appropriate hazard evaluation techniques to use in a variety of instances
- Participate in workshops in which you gain valuable practice and experience in applying a particular analytical technique to a process system
